

## MPVIII Wife Submit to Husband

*“Likewise, ye wives, be in subjection to your own husbands; that, if any obey not the word, they also may without the word be won by the conversation of the wives;”*  
*1 Peter 3:1.*

As previously mentioned, the only way to have an everlasting, equality, and very successful marriage is for the two biblical principles to exist. Regardless what others say, regardless whether you want to believe it or not, regardless whether the principle that applies to the wife might sound very sexist and politically incorrect, if any of the two biblical principles for marriage does not exist in the marriage, the marriage will fail.
